Torqueedo Powers New Electric Boats

Combining more than 50 years of aluminum boat building with the latest in electric propulsion, Torqueedo and Princecraft have joined together to create new, electric boats.

Princecraft's two, new pontoons were specifically designed around Torqueedo's electric outboards, while a fishing boat was updated to bet-

ter accommodate the motor.

The 15-foot Brio 15e and the 17-foot Brio 17e are more compact and lighter than traditional pontoons. They also incorporate battery storage for the electric motor. The 14-foot Yukon DLe fishing boat was reconfigured to better fit an electric outboard.

Torqueedo's Cruise 4.0R can push a well-stocked, 24-foot pontoon boat with 25-inch pontoons and seven people aboard at a recorded speed of 6.1 mph.
